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Executive Summary

This deliverable contains all digital objects. Students' stories will be available as they have been produced in pilot phase A and at the end of the project.

The deliverable is of "software" type and in the respective links in the STORIES web site are provided, since the contents of the digital library are public and can be accessed by all interested parties within or external to the STORIES consortium.

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Introduction

This deliverable follows the second pilot implementation phase and aims at collecting and publishing the digital objects that have been created in the project as well as the digital stories produced by students in participating schools in a special digital library. A dedicated web space has been created that allows the public to assess, read and watch the outcomes of the piloting schools. This web space is within the STORIES Website.

Concept

A new menu item called **Digital Asset Library** has been created under the Resources Menu:

Three sub-links are located there:

- a. **STORIES Library:** A library of the Stories that students have created during the implementation of the project with a search mechanism that allows the user to easily find the Stories in Country or School Level
- b. **ASSETS Repository:** A repository of the assets that students have created during the implementation of the project. Assets can be in many file formats, from single texts to 3D objects.
- c. **STORIES Toolkits & Guides:** Toolkits that the project partners have created in order to help and inspire teachers and students to imagine and create their Missions to Mars and the User

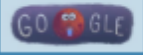
